InnoRenew CoE seeks Experts in Ukrainian development policy, business development, and the construction sector

Rebuilding a better Ukraine via the New European Bauhaus (NEB) Academy

InnoRenew CoE is implementing the "Rebuilding a better Ukraine via the New European Bauhaus (NEB) Academy" project, supported by U-LEAD with Europe Programme, to define and create the conditions for the sustainable operation of a NEB Academy Hub(s) in Ukraine that can join the NEB Academy Alliance – a network of new NEB Academy Hubs that is organizing and developing the NEB Academy in Europe.

The NEB is a movement in Europe to engage citizens and construction sector professionals in defining and building a better built environment that is inclusive, sustainable, and beautiful. The NEB Academy is a developing system of training centres (hubs) that will create and deliver relevant trainings to a broad range of construction stakeholders including sector professionals, citizens, municipal workers, policy makers, creatives, and others who express interest. The NEB Academy Hub in Ukraine will transfer knowledge to and from the Academy to enrich its offerings and transfer best practices and state-of-theart knowledge to Ukraine, with a special focus on supporting the rebuilding efforts.

To ensure national perspectives are centered in the project, are we are engaging 3 Ukrainian experts that will render their advisory and consultancy services aimed at the support of us. We are searching for experts in the following areas:

- A. Policy and legislation in Ukraine
- B. Business law and models that are possible in Ukraine
- C. Construction practice in Ukraine

The main goal of the project is to define the business model, business plan and operating conditions of a successful and sustainable NEB Academy Hub in Ukraine. To do so, the project will examine current knowledge and needs related to the built environment and sustainable building practices, develop a





















network of relevant stakeholders in Ukraine and identify potential operators of the NEB Hub in Ukraine, provide initial trainings to future trainers to prepare them to train learners in Ukraine, develop a core curriculum upon which the Hub can build its operations, and raise awareness about the NEB and the NEB Academy.

Interested candidates should have:

- an advanced degree (Master's or equivalent and higher) or equivalent experience in a relevant
 field
- previous experience in a related field (at least 5 years), ideally business development experience, which should be clearly presented in the submitted CVs.
- deep knowledge of the situation and culture in Ukraine relevant to changing construction policy and practices, training and continuing education, international collaboration
- previous experience with short-term contract work
- capability to work collaboratively on short deadlines
- initiated draft contract by which the applicant agrees no substantial changes will be made when shaping the final contract
- registered as private entrepreneur in Ukraine.

Up to one (1) expert will be contracted for each position. The services will be rendered remotely, participation in (online) meetings, and content delivery in the frame of reports.

Rejection of fees

The total payment for the services will be subject to reduction if the Expert does not fulfill their obligations as outlined in the contract.

The reduction will be based on the percentage of non-compliance. The Expert will be notified in writing of any reduction in payment, including the reasons and calculation basis. The Expert will have eight (8) days to review and respond to the assessment.

Article 5

The fee will be paid in a single payment, within 30 days after the completion of all assigned tasks within the scope of the services defined in Article 2 and 4, final report and issuance and delivery to InnoRenew CoE of the Expert's invoice.

The payment will be made in euros, on this bank account
